Rhyme Match Snap!


Phase 1 skill: Rhythm and Rhyme

Aim: Matching game using rhyme and common objects

Why this matters:

Matching Sounds and developing rhyming awareness





How to do it:

- Cut out the cards, shuffle them and place them face down.
- 2. Take turns to turn over two cards, saying the object as it's revealed.
- 3. If the two objects on the cards rhyme, the first person to shout snap wins and takes those cards into their pile.

To make it easier:

- 1. Cut out the cards, shuffle them, place them face up.
- Let your child say each object until they find its rhyming object, like a sound sorting game using rhyme.
- 3. Stick the pairs found on the sheet and colour them in.
