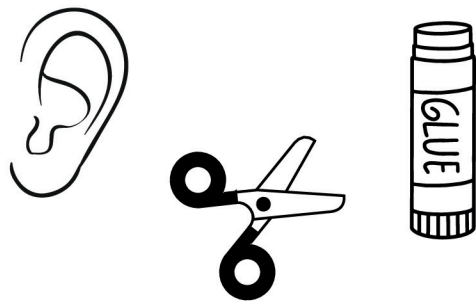
## Phase 1 skill: Environmental Sounds

**Aim: Identifying and sorting Environmental sounds**

### Why this matters:

It helps children identify and sort different sounds, a key foundation for phonics

### What you'll need:



### How to do it:

1. Let your child cut out all the everyday objects.
2. Ask: Where do we normally hear this sound for each object?
3. Let your child stick the objects onto their correct environments.

### Say this to help:

1. Can you copy the sound this object makes?
2. Does it make a loud or quiet sound?
3. Can you hear that sound right now?
