

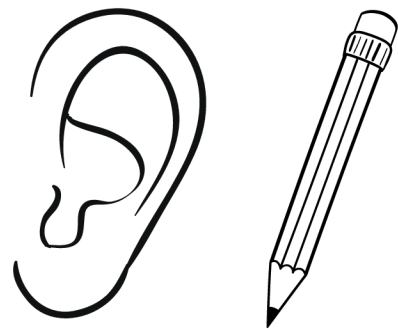
Blend and Find

Phase 1 skill: Oral Blending

Aim: Say the CVC word and then find it in the picture

Why this matters:
Children practice oral blending by listening to the sounds in a word

What you'll need:



How to do it:

1. You say the sounds in a word slowly (e.g. c-a-t).
2. Your child blends the sounds to say the full word (cat!).
3. They search the scene and circle the matching picture.
4. Repeat until all the words are said and matching pictures found.

To make it easier:

1. Say the sounds slowly.
2. Repeat the sounds a couple times if needed.
3. Move on to the next word if needed.
4. Make it playful.

Blend and Find

For Parents - Say the sounds slowly, then let your child say the word and find its matching picture



m-a-p > map

d-o-g > dog

c-a-t > cat

r-a-t > rat

b-a-t > bat

l-o-g > log

s-u-n > sun
